

SURGICAL MASKS



- A correct surgical mask must be worn at every service
- Ensure the nose piece is adjusted to close over the top of nasal bridge
- Ensure the loops are securely around your ears
- Your mask must be changed either after every service OR every 4 hours if on the same service
- Never 'hang' your mask off your ear. If you need to remove your mask for any reason you will need to replace it
- Cloth Masks are NOT to be worn on a service

Please note:

Always be aware of your movements. What are you touching? Do you need to adjust your mask, if so, do you need to change your mask? Do you need to Sanitise?

Removal and Disposal of Your Mask

- 1 Ensure you have left the premises of the house/service venue and have access to a garbage bag and bin (you must still be outdoor at the premises)
- 2 Sanitise your hands and allow to dry (at least 10 seconds)
- 3 Remove your mask by the ear straps, place into garbage bag, seal and place into appropriate bin
- 4 Sanitise your hands and allow to dry (at least 10 seconds) before entering your car/ public transport

GLOVES



- Gloves must be worn during the following services
 - Personal Care or any Personal contact with a participant
 - Food Preparation of any form
 - Domestic cleaning service or any form of cleaning
 - In the instance that you are required to touch anything external to yourself
- Gloves must be worn as a **ONE TIME USE** only. They must be changed if you are changing the form of service, you are providing, and **MUST** be disposed of at the end of each service.
- You **MUST NOT WASH** or **SANITISE** gloves

Removal and Disposal of Your Gloves

- 1 You must remove your gloves whilst IN the participants premises. Ensure you have access to a garbage bag, an open bin ready and are no longer required to touch anything further
- 2 Remove your gloves, place into garbage bag, seal and place into appropriate bin
- 3 Sanitise your hands and allow to dry (at least 10 seconds)
- 4 Avoid touching anything further as you exit the service and use you elbow to open doors when possible.
- 5 Follow Mask removal procedure.
- 6 Sanitise your hands and allow to dry (at least 10 seconds) before entering your car/ public transport

Please note:

All other forms of PPE are optional if there is no Covid or Suspected Covid Case
