### Notes

- Rates effective from 01 July 2024
- Services listed that are charged at an hourly rate require a minimum service duration of two hours.
- Establishment Fee: A fee of \$675.60 will be charged against a new plan where it is agreed that Afea will provide supports for a minimum of 20 hours/month for three or more consecutive months.
- This Fee Schedule is in compliance with NDIS Pricing Arrangements and Price Limits for 2024-2025.
- Rates are exclusive of GST. All home care services are GST exempt.
- To ensure quality of care and under NSW Fair Work, our carers can work a maximum of 10 hours per day and 38 hours per week.

### Cancellation Policy

A short cancellation (or no show) is defined by Afea as when there is failure to provide 24 business hours' notice for a support or service.

Providers may claim the full amount of the fee associated with the support service, when the agreed cancellation notice period is not met.

While the NDIA recommends seven clear business days' notice of cancellation for Disability Support Worker-related supports, **Afea is proud to offer a cancellation policy that offers better terms for NDIS participants where you only need to provide 24 business hours' notice if you wish to cancel a service.**
